14 Based upon the Ex Parte Application of Portor Goltz, Deputy County Counsel, as attorney for
15 the Office of the San Mateo County Public Guardian, and, for good cause appearing,

16 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

17 1. That the Public Guardian for the County of San Mateo is the agency designated to serve as
18 Probate Conservator of the Person and Estate of those individuals who are unable to meet their basic
19 needs for physical health, food, clothing, or shelter, and/or who are unable to manage his/her own
20 financial resources or resist fraud or undue influence when no other person is appointed to serve in that
21 capacity. The Public Guardian for the County of San Mateo is appointed as Conservator of the Person
22 and Estate in LPS Conservatorship proceedings when the individual under the disability of the
23 Conservatorship is suffering from a mental illness or mental disease.

24 2. That Margaret Taylor is the duly appointed Public Guardian for the County of San Mateo.
25 By way of this Order, the Court hereby authorizes the individuals named in this Order to execute any
26 document required for the sale or transfer of real property and/or personal property, including all stock
27 and cash reserve transfers and redemption of bonds. The individuals who are authorized to execute
28 these documents on behalf of and in the place of Margaret Taylor are:

5 3. That a signature of any of the above-named individuals shall have the same force and effect
6 in relation to the above-described activities as if executed personally by Margaret Taylor, the Public

9 effect until it has been revoked by the Court.


