

WHEREAS, the California Rules of Court, Rule 6.660(b)(1) specifies that in order to be eligible for appointment as a subordinate judicial officer the candidate must be “admitted to practice law in California for at least ten years or, upon a finding of good cause by the presiding judge, for at least five years; and

WHEREAS, the court did make a finding of good cause that Stephanie Garratt was qualified to serve as a Commissioner for this Court, pursuant to Rule 6.660(b)(1), when she was selected by the Court and appointed as a Court Commissioner.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT, pursuant to California Rules of Court, Rule 6.660 (b)(1), the Court finds that there is good cause to appoint Stephanie Garratt Commissioner of the Superior Court of California, County of San Mateo effective September 15, 2004, Nunc Pro Tunc.
