Coronavirus Pandemic

The Court, in an effort to follow the guidelines that were recently released by Cal/Osha, hereby begins the process of releasing some of the restrictions that have been placed on certain calendars. This Order shall remain in effect through July 30, 2021.

Effective July 6, 2021, the Court will:

- Resume hearing civil jury trials.
- Resume hearing LPS and long-cause Probate trials.
- Resume hearing the Prop. 63 Noncompliance calendar.
- Resume hearing the Domestic Violence Pretrial Conference calendar.
- Resume hearing the Domestic Violence Review calendar.

For family law cases, please see the latest family law memo, titled "Family Law COVID-19 Protocols and FAQs", updated January 26, 2021, which can be accessed on the court's website at www.sanmateocourt.org. Family Law Status Conferences will resume on August 2, 2021.

For juvenile cases, please see the most recent juvenile memo, titled "Juvenile Dependency and Juvenile Justice Memo #7", dated November 3, 2020, which can also be accessed on the court's website.

- Presiding Judge Master Calendar: All matters on the Master Calendar will be heard
 except for Small Claims Appeals. All cases set for Small Claims Appeal through July 30,
 2021 will be continued. The Presiding Judge retains the discretion to hear any matters
 which, in the interest of justice, the Presiding Judge determines should be heard. Zoom
 audio appearances, instead of CourtCall, will be allowed with prior authorization from
 the Presiding Judge (Zoom credentials for the Master Calendar are listed on the court's
 website at www.sanmateocourt.org).
- Presiding Judge ex partes (Monday Friday from 2:00 2:15 P.M.): The Presiding Judge will consider temporary restraining order requests and eviction stays only.
- All matters set on the Family Law Support (DCSS) calendar (Wednesdays at 9:00 A.M. and Thursdays at 2:00 P.M.) will be heard. Zoom appearances will be allowed.

Clerk's Offices
