STANDING ORDER RE: EX PARTE
APPLICATIONS PROCEDURES AND
FORMAT IN FELONY CASES

WHEREAS, On July 1, 2010, the Court issued a Standing Order setting the time schedule for presenting ex parte applications before the Criminal Presiding Judge for review and the format for ex parte applications; and

WHEREAS, it has become necessary for the Court to revise the time schedule for the presentation of ex parte applications to coincide with the Clerk's Office hours of operation


NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED, effective September 1, 2010, ex parte applications in felony cases shall proceed as follows:

- 1. Ex Parte applications shall be presented to the Criminal Presiding Judge in Department 2A at the Hall of Justice and Records as follows:
 - Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday presented between 3:30 to 4:00 PM
 - Thursday presented between 8:00 to 8:30 AM
- 2. Each ex parte application shall be in writing, accompanied by a memorandum of points and authorities, and declaration making the required factual showing, and a proposed order, as provided for in California Rule of Court (CRC) Rules 3.1201 and 3.1202.

1 3. Written notice shall be provided to opposing counsel as defined in CRC Rules
2 3.1203 and 3.1204.

3 4. This order shall supersede this Court's Standing Order 10-106 dated July 1, 2010.
