WHEREAS, California Rules of Court (CRC), Rule 4.530(d) requires either a requesting probation officer of a transferring jurisdiction or party requesting transfer, under Penal Code § 1203.9, to give notice of the motion to transfer probation to persons listed in the Rule; and

WHEREAS, CRC, Rule 4.530(1) requires that the notice of the motion to transfer must include the place where the hearing is to be held and the time of the hearing; and

WHEREAS, the scope of this Standing Order pertains to setting hearings in the transferring court only; and


WHEREAS, in the interest of providing direction to comply with these requirements, this Superior Court makes the following designations:

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED, that motions for inter-county probation transfers under Penal Code § 1203.9 from San Mateo County are to be set for hearing through the Clerk's Office as follows:

- a) For felony cases, on the Criminal Presiding Judge's Calendar.
- b) For misdemeanor and infraction cases, on the Preliminary Hearing calendar.

1 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that this order supersedes any previous order(s)
2 regarding this subject matter and shall remain in effect indefinitely and until such time as the
3 order is vacated or superseded by order of the Presiding Judge.
