**STANDING ORDER RE: DELETING OR TRANSFERRING COLLECTION  
OF FINES, FEES, RESTITUTION, RESTITUTION FINES ORDERED BY THE COURT  
ON CASES WHICH ARE READMITTED TO SUPERVISED PROBATION IN THE  
"ADMINISTRATIVE" CASE CATEGORY  
(Penal Code 1214 and 1214.2)**

**GOOD CAUSE APPEARING** that, in cases where the defendant is readmitted to supervised probation, and that case is designated by the Court to be "Administrative"; or

In cases where the defendant is at or near the end of a probation period; and

A balance of a fine, fee, restitution, or restitution fine, previously ordered by the Court to be paid through the Probation Department, remains to be paid and that balance is not as a result of willful failure to pay by the defendant; and

The failure to pay the remaining balance is not deemed by the Probation Officer to constitute a probation violation;

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the balance of the fine, fee, restitution, or restitution fine which is in excess of Fifty Dollars (\$50) be transferred to the County Revenue Services Department for collection in the same manner as a civil judgment.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that any balance of a fine, fee, restitution or restitution fine which is less than Fifty Dollars (\$50), deemed not appropriate for collection by County Revenue Services Department, be deleted and removed from the Probation Department Accounts.

This order shall supersede any previous order(s) and shall remain in effect indefinitely and until such time as the order is vacated or superseded by the Presiding Judge.
