STANDING ORDER RE: COMPLIANCE WITH NOTICE OF REVIEW
PROBATE DEPARTMENT

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING THEREFOR, based on the statutory requirements for a court review of all conservatorships one year after the appointment of the conservator and biennially thereafter,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Clerk of this court shall, from time to time, notify conservators in advance of each date, such notice is to be in writing and is to be served by mail on each conservator review approximately 120 days in advance of the review date;
2. Each conservator, so notified, shall promptly comply with the terms and provisions of the Notice of Review so issued and served;
3. Failure so to comply by any such conservator shall subject such conservator to further enforcement proceedings, including but not by way of limitation, adjudication of contempt and punishment;
4. This order shall take effect immediately.

This order shall supersede any previous order(s) and shall remain in effect indefinitely and until such time as the order is vacated or superseded by the Presiding Judge.
