STANDING ORDER RE: FLEXIBLE SURRENDER DATES

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that for any self-surrender commitment with a surrender date of six weeks or more after the imposition of sentence, the Sheriff's Department may require the defendant to surrender fifteen days prior to or fifteen days after the surrender date written on the commitment. Defendant shall be notified in writing of the new surrender date.

This order shall supersede any previous order(s) and shall remain in effect indefinitely and until such time as the order is vacated or superseded by the Presiding Judge.
