**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Public Guardian in and for the County of San Mateo shall not be required to file accountings in conformity with Probate Code Sections 1060 - 1064, which are effective July 1, 1997, until after October 1, 1997. All accountings filed with the Clerk of the Court and heard prior to October 1, 1997, shall be in conformity with the current Probate Code accounting requirements.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that this order shall supersede any previous order(s) and shall remain in effect indefinitely and until such time as the order is vacated or superseded by the Presiding Judge.

18 This application for a limited Standing Order of the San Mateo County Superior Court is made  
19 on behalf of the San Mateo County Public Guardian in all probate conservatorship cases in which it now  
20 serves as conservator which are on file with the Clerk of the San Mateo County Superior Court.

21 Probate Code Sections 1060-1064, inclusive, were amended effective July 1, 1997. The new code  
22 requirements change the essential format and requirements for accountings filed with the Court and heard  
23 by the Court after July 1, 1997.

24 The San Mateo County Public Guardian subscribes to the accounting system utilized by the vast  
25 majority of Public Guardian offices throughout the State of California, the Pacific Western Information  
26 System CompuTrust Accounting System. This system is not currently formatted to allow inclusion of  
27 the requirements of the new Probate Code requirements such as detailed fair market value for real and  
28 designated personal property. Pacific Western Information Systems is currently attempting to modify



1 its current accounting program to address the new Probate Code requirements but this process will not  
2 be completed until October 1, 1997.

3 It is therefore requested that the Court grant a limited Standing Order extending the current  
4 Probate Code accounting requirements and allowing the San Mateo County Public Guardian to delay  
5 implementation of the new Probate Code Sections 1060-1064 until after October 1, 1997. The Court  
6 Investigator has met and conferred with the Chief Deputy Public Guardian and concurs with this request  
7 that the Court allow a deferment of the application of these new code requirements until October 1, 1997.
