CHILD WELFARE INVESTIGATIONS) ORDER

HAVING CONSIDERED the best interests of children whose welfare status is investigated by the San Mateo County Department of Social Services and finding that the ascertainment of all information relevant to the present condition and future welfare of children upon whose behalf dependency petitions are brought requires a determination of such minors' caretakers and prospective caretakers criminal history background, the Court orders, adjudges and decrees pursuant to the inherent power of the court, the provisions of California Welfare and Institutions Code section 350, California Penal Code sections 11166 and 11166.3, and Juvenile Rule of Court 1412, as follows:

1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, upon the request of an employee of the San Mateo County Department of

1 Social Services, all San Mateo County police agencies shall
2 facilitate assistance to the children whose welfare is
3 investigated by the San Mateo County Department of Social
4 Services by providing to said Department of Social Services
5 employee the complete criminal history information, of both a
6 traffic and criminal variety, of any caretaker or prospective
7 caretaker of a child who is the subject of an investigation
8 pertaining to child welfare within the jurisdiction of the police
9 agency so requested.

10 2. The San Mateo County Department of Social Services
11 shall not disseminate such criminal history information to any
12 person except in the course of a dependency proceeding brought
13 pursuant to the provisions of Section 300 of the Welfare and
14 Institutions Code.

15 3. This order shall remain in perpetual effect until
16 otherwise ordered.
