16 Based upon the Ex Parte Application of Steven L. Dylina, Deputy County Counsel as attorney
17 for the Office of the San Mateo County Public Guardian and, good cause appearing,

18 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

19 1. The Public Guardian for the County of San Mateo is the agency designated to serve as
20 Probate Conservator of the Person and Estate of those individuals who are unable to meet their basic
21 needs for physical health, food, clothing, or shelter, and/or who are unable to manage his/her own
22 financial resources or resist fraud or undue influence when no other person is appointed to serve in
23 that capacity. The Public Guardian for the County of San Mateo is appointed as Conservator of the
24 Person and Estate in LPS Conservatorship proceedings when the individual under the disability of the
25 Conservatorship is suffering from a mental illness or mental disease.

26 2. Margaret Taylor, is the duly appointed Public Guardian for the County of San Mateo. By
27 way of this Order, the Court hereby authorizes the individuals named in this Order to execute any
28 document or tax return required to be filed in conjunction with a tax return with the Internal Revenue
Service or with the California State Franchise Tax Board or with any other agency designated for this

I, STEVEN L. DYLINE, declare as follows:

1. This application for an ex parte standing order is made on behalf of the Public Guardian for the County of San Mateo in relation to the Probate Conservatorship and LPS Conservatorship cases now pending before the Court.

2. Margaret Taylor, the Director of Public Health for the County of San Mateo, is also designated Public Guardian for the county of San mateo. Part of the responsibility of the Public Guardian is to file tax returns, where appropriate, for those individuals currently under either a

22 designated Public Guardian for the county of San Mateo. Part of the responsibility of the Public
23 Guardian is to file tax returns, where appropriate, for those individuals currently under either a
24 Probate Conservatorship or an LPS Conservatorship.

25 3. This application is made to the court seeking a standing order which will allow the
26 individuals listed below to sign the more than four hundred (400) tax returns which must be
27 completed and mailed prior to April 15, each year. This application is made with the knowledge of
28 and at the direction of Margaret Taylor, the Public Guardian for the County of San Mateo.
