January	Fred Korematsu Day	Honoring civil rights and courage through the legacy of Fred Korematsu.
	A Day in Court	Students step inside the courtroom to learn how justice works.
February	Mock Trial	Empowering students to explore the justice system through hands-on experience.

Year-Round	Court Visits	Community organizations and educational institutions can participate in organized court visits tailored to their age, educational purpose, and time needs. Large groups are encouraged to arrange visits in advance.
	Mock Trial	Teachers and organizations may request a courthouse visit for a mock trial, providing students with a better understanding of the third branch of government and the roles of participants in a trial.
	Speakers	Judges and judicial officers may speak to students, adults, and community groups on a variety of topics and may administer oaths for school government and club ceremonies. Ethical rules limit the topics judicial officers may discuss.
	School & Community Outreach	The Court Community Outreach Committee provides opportunities to engage with the Court through courthouse visits or by scheduling a judicial officer to visit a school.
