IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, commencing May 1, 2025, and continuing until modified by the Presiding Judge of the San Mateo County Superior Court, all Probate jury and court trials, excluding fee waiver cases, restraining orders, and cases tried under the Lanterman-Petris-Short conservatorship act, will require litigants to bring their own court reporter.

All procedures for request for fee waivers and court reporters supplied by the court will remain in effect.
