WHEREAS, the San Mateo County Superior Court previously issued Standing Order 25-182 and 25-187, Regarding Availability and Use of Court Provided Court Reporters in Probate dated April 11, 2025 & April 17, 2025 pertaining to all Probate jury and court trials, excluding fee waiver cases, restraining orders, and cases tried under the Lanterman-Petris-Short conservatorship act, will require litigants to bring their own court reporter.

AND WHEREAS, the Presiding Judge Stephanie G. Garratt has determined that the standing order is no longer necessary or appropriate;

IT IS HEREY ORDERED that:

1. Standing Orders 25-182 and 25-187, Regarding Availability and Use of Court Provided Court Reporters in Probate dated April 11, 2025 and April 17, 2025 are hereby rescinded in its entirety, effective immediately.
2. All procedures, directives, or requirements set forth in the rescind order are no longer in force.
